School Trip for Year 3 and 4

In our phase, we were extremely enthusiastic about our PE lessons, we often link them with science and our topic themes. We want to shine a light on how important PE is and how it can teach the pupils so much that will benefit them across the whole curriculum, because of this, our upcoming trip will centre around physical education.

Throughout the day next Thursday 21st March, we have three time slots at St Stephens' Rock Up Hull, which is a climbing experience centre and their educational sessions have been tailor-made to suit our curriculum by the same company who designed the Harry Potter World education packs. Pupils will be exploring the impact of exercise on the body as well as using their maths skills to conquer problem solving challenges throughout their 1 hour climbing session. Rock Up is a very popular attraction and so we have been waiting for confirmation of our date, hence the delay in sending out this letter. When they are not climbing, the pupils will be working through a carousel of activities in Hull City Centre, including visits to the museums and a break to eat their lunches.

The Friends of the School have kindly donated £250 towards the total cost of the trip which includes: £180 for the coaches and £500 for Rock Up, this means that the cost per pupil will only be **£5.00**. This is fantastic value as normal prices for an under 16 year old at Rock up starts at £8 each and goes up to over £11 on a weekend. Please pay via ParentPay as soon as possible. Unfortunately, if we do not receive everybody's payment, this amazing trip will have to be cancelled.

Because of the nature of the activity, it is essential that the pupils wear their outdoor PE kits for the duration of the day. Please ensure the trainers are comfortable and that pupils are prepared for a range of weather! Every child will need a healthy packed lunch on the day without glass bottles or fizzy drinks and in a disposable bag. If you child is entitled to free school meals and requires a school packed lunch for the trip, please let a member of staff know as soon as possible.
