As Mathematicians we will:

In Year 5:

- Multiply and divide whole numbers and those involving decimals by 10, 100 and 1000.
- Distinguish between regular and irregular polygons based on reasoning about equal sides and angles.
- Know angles are measured in degrees: estimate and compare acute, obtuse and reflex angles.
- Draw given angles, and measure them in degrees.
- Describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation.
- Convert between different units of metric measure.
- Estimate volume and capacity.

In Year 6:

- Complete mathematical investigations involving taught skills.

As Scientists we will learn about Living Things and Their Habitats by:

- Describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird.
- Describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.
- Planning different types of scientific enquiries to answer questions, including recognising and controlling variables where necessary.

In Computing we will:

- Use sequence, selections and repetition in programs; work with variables and various forms of input and output.
- Use search technologies effectively, appreciate how results are selected and ranked, and be discerning in evaluating digital content.
- Use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly.

In Literacy we will be:

In Year 5:

Performing and reciting scenes from the Shakespeare play 'Macbeth' culminating in a performance at Hull Truck Theatre. We will also be continuing our written work on the book 'The Nowhere Emporium'.

In Year 6:

Studying The World Cup and using skills developed through reading and writing lessons to complete group work. We will also be studying poetry and as individuals and in groups, write and perform our own pieces.
