Year 1:

- add and subtract numbers
- describe position, direction and movement.

Year 2:

- add and subtract numbers
- recognise the £ and p symbol and combine different coins to make different amounts.
- solve money problems which will include finding change.

As Design and Technology artists:

- design purposeful, functional, appealing products for ourselves and other users based on design criteria.

In literacy we will:

Year 1 reading:

- apply phonic knowledge to decode words.
- respond speedily with the correct sound to graphemes.
- read common exception words, noting unusual correspondences between spellings and sounds.

Year 1 writing:

- use finger spaces, capital letters, full stops.
- say out loud what we are going to write about.
- compose a sentence orally before writing it.
- sequencing sentences from short narratives
- re-read what we have written to check it makes sense.

Year 2 reading:

- continue to apply phonic knowledge when needed.
- read words containing common suffixes.
- understand both the books that we can already read accurately and fluently and those we listen to.

Year 2 writing:

- write about real events, poetry and different purposes.
- use contractions for possession.
- use statements, commands, exclamations and question type sentences in writing.

In RE our topic is Preparation (Advent)

We will:

- know and understand about preparing for special times.
- know and understand that Advent is four weeks of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus at Christmas.
