

Foundation Stage Summer 1

Maths:

FS1- learning a new number rhyme every week with actions, talking about numbers that are important to us and experimenting with number mark making.

FS2- Placing numbers in the correct order, using numbers in the environment. We will be using money in everyday situations. Looking at using time and begin to use halving and sharing in problem solving activities.

Literacy:

FS1- mark making everywhere! We will use lots of different mark making tools to experiment with both indoors and outdoors. We will practise writing our name, captions and labels.

FS2- Use our green and red words when writing sentences. Use our phonics to support writing. Begin to think of our choice of language in our story writing.

Reading:

FS1- We will be reading poetry 'A Picnic Tea' by David Harmer: a wonderful rhyming poem, which links nicely into our topic of Mini-beasts.

FS2- will be reading poetry 'A Picnic Tea' by David Harman. This and other poems will allow the children to experience new and interesting vocabulary and look at rhyming. We will continue to use 'Talk for Writing' to support our work.

Knowledge & Understanding:

We will be finding out about the different types of minibeasts which live in the environment. We will look closely at the life cycle of a butterfly and be finding out about spiders

Technology:

We will be taking using the ipads to take photographs of mini-beasts and using the beebots. We will use our light box to create our own images.

Expressive art & design:

We will be creating human sculptures using recycled materials. We will learn the art of weaving to create our own spider webs. Our painting skills are developing well and we will use this skill to paint on stones to create a desired effect. We will also be making spider puppets.

Physical development:

We will continue to work with Mr. Stones from St Mary's College. We will be using the skills we have learnt and developing these in gymnastics.
