Literacy Year 1

- Apply phonic knowledge to decode words.
- Respond speedily with the correct sound to graphemes
- Read common exception words, noting unusual correspondences between spellings and sounds.
- Using finger spaces, capital letters, full stops.
- Saying out loud what they are going to write about.
- Composing a sentence orally before writing it.
- Sequencing sentences from short narratives.
- Re-reading what they have written to check it makes sense.

Literacy Year 2

- Continue to apply phonic knowledge when needed.
- Read words containing common suffixes.
- Understand both the books that they can already read accurately and fluently and those they listen to.
- Write about real events, poetry and different purposes.
 - Write in the present tense .
 - Write in the past tense.
 - Use exclamation marks

Pupils will:

Year 1:

- Add by counting on.
- Find number bonds to 20.
- Add within 20 by finding 10 first.

Year 2:

- Solve problems by multiplying and dividing by 2,5, 10 and 3.
