

In Maths we will:

Year 1: Divide and multiply numbers.

Measure and begin to record the following:

- ❖ lengths and heights
- ❖ mass/weight
- ❖ capacity and volume
- ❖ time (hours, minutes, seconds)

Year 2: Divide and multiply numbers.

Choose and use appropriate standards of units to estimate and measure. Tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

In Design & Technology, we will be looking at Carnivals: We will:

- Design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves and other users based on design criteria.
- Generate, develop, model and communicate their ideas through talking, drawing, templates, mock-ups and, where appropriate, information and communication technology.
- Explore and evaluate a range of existing products.

In computing: We will:

- Use our word processing skills on ipads to make a power point presentation presenting facts about Carnivals around the World.

In RE, our topics are 'Being Sorry' (Year 1) and 'Rules and Reconciliation' (Year 2) We will learn that:

- We have choices - sometimes we choose well, and sometimes wrongly
- God helps us to choose well and to be sorry. God forgives us.

As Geographers, we will:

- Ask and answer geographical questions (such as: What is this place like? What or who will I see in this place? What do people do in this place?).
- Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans studied.
- Name and locate the world's continents and oceans.

In PE: Pupils will:

- Develop agility and coordination skills
- Perform a single skill or movement with some control
- Perform a small range of skills and link movements together
- Develop catching, throwing and hitting skills.

In Literacy we will:

Year 1 reading:

- Apply phonic knowledge to decode words.
- Respond speedily with the correct sound to graphemes.
- Read common exception words, noting unusual correspondences between spellings and sounds.

Year 1 writing:

- Use finger spaces, capital letters, full stops.
- Say out loud what we are going to write about.
- Compose a sentence orally before writing it.
- Sequencing sentences from short narratives
- Re-read what we have written to check it makes sense.

Year 2 reading:

- Continue to apply phonic knowledge when needed.
- Read words containing common suffixes.
- Understand both the books that they can already read accurately and fluently and those they listen to.

Year 2 writing:

- Write about real events, poetry and different purposes.
- Write in the present tense.
- Write in the past tense.
- Use exclamation marks
- Finish questions with a question mark.

As Scientists, we will learn about Plants. We will:

- Identify, classify and describe their basic structure.
- Observe and describe growth and conditions for growth.
- Observe closely, using simple equipment.
- Perform simple tests.
- Identify and classify.
- Use observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions.
- Gather and record data to help in answering questions.
