Dear Parent,

The children in Phase 2 have worked extremely hard throughout this academic year. For our summer trip, we searched for the perfect place to reward their hard work by giving them the chance to apply what they have learnt across the curriculum to an outdoor forest school. Unfortunately, the sheer size of the phase meant this proved difficult to source.

Although we recognise it is late notice, we have arranged a trip for this Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July. Throughout the course of the academic year, Phase 2 have been studying the UN's 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) focussing on how to make the world a better place by 2030.
